Town Council Meeting  
April 2, 2018

Meeting called to order by Mayor Melton at 7:00 P.M.

Leah Higginbotham, Alisa Scott, Barbara Reed, Billy Whittington, and Jenny Leighton were present.

The Pledge of Allegiance.

Barbara Reed made motion to approve March 5<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup>, 14<sup>th</sup>, and 21<sup>st</sup> minutes as read, Leah Higginbotham seconded, motion carried unanimously.

Leah Higginbotham made motion to approve payments from July 1, 2017 through March 31, 2018, Alisa Scott seconded, motion carried unanimously.

Mayor Melton introduced Brenda Hill who requested approval of an application to place a manufactured home on 113 Pickens Avenue.

Council unanimously agreed to approve Brenda Hill's application of the manufactured home.

Mayor Melton introduced Terry Call who requested approval of an application to place a manufactured home at a lot on Barber Shop Lane.

Council unanimously agreed to approve Terry Call's application of the manufactured home.

The Recorder handed council an Budget Revision #5, that decreases Streets & Highways by \$9500.00, and increases City Attorney \$2000.00, City Hall \$3000.00, and the Library \$4500.00 to account for divider doors and annual contribution to library plus other anticipated expenditures for the remainder of the year.

Barbara Reed made motion to approve Budget Revision #5 and submit a resolution, Jenny Leighton seconded, motion carried unanimously.

Mayor Melton mentioned that the Town Engineer Roger Randolph gave him an estimate of \$25,000 to replace the Wrights Lane bridge and put in a boxed culvert.

Mayor Melton informed council that he received several mail notices, one from DEP about a \$5000.00 grant that we could apply for in purpose of a town cleanup, another a recycling grant for up to \$75000.00, and another from Solid Waste in the amount of \$40000.00.
