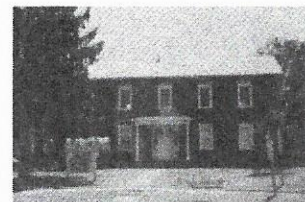

Special Town Meeting
December 21, 2017

Meeting called to order by Mayor Melton at 7:02 P.M.
Leah Higginbotham, Alisa Scott, Barbara Reed, Billy Whittington, and Jenny Leighton were present.

The new B&O Tax Form added service business or calling and changed the rate for contracting from 0.75 to 1.50 per \$100.

Barbara Reed made motion to accept the new B&O Tax Form and to amend ordinances as necessary, Alisa Scott seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

Executive Session called to order by Mayor Melton at 7:15 P.M.
Executive Session closed and special meeting reconvened at 8:15 P.M.

Billy Whittington made motion to increase the wage in the amount of \$2.00/ hour for Thomas Hammonds starting January 1, 2018, Jenny Leighton seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

Barbara Reed made motion to increase the salary from \$1525.00/ monthly to \$1800.00/ monthly for Andrew Coulson starting February 1, 2018, Jenny Leighton seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

Mayor Melton discussed the order of 4 pallets of Hole Patch at \$15.50 per 50lb. bag to fix streets. It could be used to fix Frazier Lane if approved at the next meeting.

Buffalo Sewer upgraded their accounting software to what is currently being used with the governmental funds.

Council discussed replacing both town signs.

Barbara Reed made motion to adjourn, Alisa Scott seconded. Meeting adjourned at 9:31 P.M.
