

Town Council Meeting
July 1, 2019

Meeting called to order by Mayor Cain at 7:00 P.M.
Terry Parsons, Doug Pierson, Leah Higginbotham, Chad Thaxton and Barbara Reed were present.
The Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Cain introduced Nancy Shifflet and Janet Leslie with the Kanawha Valley Daughters of American Revolution to present the Town with an award for

Leah Higginbotham made motion to approve the June minutes as read, Barbara Reed seconded, motion carried unanimously.

Doug Pierson made motion to approve payments from June 1st through present date, Leah Higginbotham seconded, motion carried unanimously.

Chief Will Jordan gave the police report.

Mayor Cain introduced Chad Thaxton, the owner of Buffalo Tire and Brake, who is disputing the B&O Tax Assessment, for the 2nd, 3rd, and 4th Quarters of 2018. Mr. Thaxton introduced Jill Adams, his accounting representative, who confirmed the amended returns for all quarters in question were to be true and accurate, and that they were properly separated between retail and service as required by Article 110.

Ron Flora, the Town Attorney, mentioned to Council that they needed to decide whether to accept the amended returns as requested in the letters, based upon the representation of Ms. Adams.

Barbara Reed made motion to accept the amended returns prepared by Mrs. Adams, Terry Parsons seconded, all voted in favor except Leah Higginbotham, who opposed. Motion Carried by majority.

Mayor Cain mentioned to Council that the Vandalia Growers had a successful meet and greet with the town last month, and that they did confirm it would be providing over 400 jobs.

Mayor Cain said he is still waiting to hear back from the Jellystone representatives.

Leah Higginbotham mentioned that the new playground equipment is scheduled to be installed on July 2, 2019.

Barbara Reed mentioned that the July 4th celebration is still happening and that everything is all ready to go.

Mayor Cain mentioned that the application and ads for the Small Cities Block Grant have been filed and that we are waiting to hear back.
