Town Council Meeting July 5, 2022

Meeting called to order by Mayor Cain at 7:00 P.M.

Doug Pierson, Leah Higginbotham, Terry Parsons, Chad Thaxton, and Barbara Reed were present.

The Pledge of Allegiance.

Barbara Reed made motion to approve the June minutes as read, Leah Higginbotham seconded, motion carried unanimously.

Chad Thaxton made motion to approve payments from June 1st to present date, Terry Parsons seconded, motion carried unanimously.

Mayor Cain briefed Council on the Sewer Board Minutes.

Chief Will Jordan gave the Police Report.

Mayor Cain introduced Senator Glenn Jefferies who mentioned a few updates regarding some infrastructure projects throughout his district which includes Buffalo. He mentioned that the money for repaying is coming in, there are still some steps needing completed. He mentioned that he has put in for a total of 28 new paying projects, 8 are on the north side of Putnam County and will be back roads. He mentioned that the entrance to 18 mile creek road and route 62 will be widened which is to accommodate Vandalia Growers.

Andrew Coulson (Recorder) mentioned to Council, that the recommendation of the Town Attorney, regarding Comfort Carriers Tax Assessment, is to place a lien on the business to recover the amount of money owed in B&O taxes. In addition, Council discussed adding the attorney fees throughout to the lien.

Leah Higginbotham made motion to place a lien on Comfort carriers for the tax assessment amount due plus legal fees, Doug Pierson seconded, motion carried unanimously.

Mayor Cain updated Council on the Krystal Lane Project. Pre bid meeting will be happening soon.

Mayor Cain updated Council on the sidewalk grant. The State has just now informed us they want us to ad in the Charleston Gazette as required by the DOH.

Mayor Cain updated Council on the basketball court. We will need to put it out for bid still and we need to figure out the exact location for it.
