Town Council Meeting  
March 4, 2019

Meeting called to order by Mayor Cain at 7:00 P.M.

Chad Thaxton, Doug Pierson, Terry Parsons, Leah Higginbotham, and Barbara Reed were present.

The Pledge of Allegiance.

Barbara Reed made motion to approve the February minutes as read, Chad Thaxton seconded, motion carried unanimously.

Doug Pierson made motion to approve payments from February 1<sup>st</sup> through present date, Leah Higginbotham seconded, motion carried unanimously.

Chief Will Jordan gave the police report.

Mayor Conrad Cain introduced Susan Erwin to Council. She expressed concerns with buildings around her property that are in very poor condition, hazardous and a potential for dangers, and many stray cats around the property. She mentioned that she had put a lot of money into her property and that with the surrounding properties in the area and around town being in poor condition, she fears that her property value will decrease, and that businesses will not want to come into town. She mentioned that she would very much like to see low income housing of some form being built here in Buffalo. She also expressed concerns with the garbage collection and their inaccuracies with its collection.

Mayor Conrad Cain mentioned to Council that a representative from Vandalia wanted to be connected to Buffalo Sewer service. He mentioned that a portion of their property would be in town but the representative has expressed to him that they do not want to come into town, however, still want to get sewer service.

Mayor Cain mentioned to Council that he will be sending information gathered from Randolph Engineering to Payne & Garlow, to get the Wrights Lane Bridge added to the insurance. He said that he was told there needed to be a couple sharp turn signs added on each side.

Barbara Reed mentioned that it was brought to her attention that portions of the sidewalk in town are in poor condition and are hazardous.

Leah Higginbotham made motion to adjourn, Barbara Reed seconded, meeting adjourned at 8:00 P.M.
