Town Meeting
March 5, 2018

Meeting called to order by Mayor Melton at 7:00 P.M.

Leah Higginbotham, Alisa Scott, Barbara Reed, Billy Whittington, and Jenny Leighton were present.

The Pledge of Allegiance.

Alisa Scott made motion to approve February 5th, 22nd, and March 1st minutes as read, Leah Higginbotham seconded, motion carried unanimously.

Mayor Melton notified council that the Buffalo Sewer Board approved the proposed amounts for rental of town property.

Mayor Melton discussed the plan for creating the 2019 budget and the timeframe for which it would be done.

Mayor Melton proposed on behalf of Police Chief Jordan, "An Ordinance Amending Article 5 General Offenses Code TO Add Article 533.11 Drug and Gang Houses, Houses of Prostitution and other Disorderly Houses and 533.12 Order of Abatement and to Amend Article 533.99 Penalty to Add 533.99(b)(4) to be adopted and for the first reading to be done March 8, 2018.

Alisa Scott proposed using Coal Severance monies to pay for the addition of various lights throughout Buffalo.

Leah Higginbotham made motion to adjourn, Barbara Reed seconded, meeting adjourned at 8:40 P.M.
